- Let Someone Know Your Plans: Before heading out, let someone know where you're going and when you expect to be back.


Enjoy the fresh air and sunshine, but remember to prioritize your safety!

Planned Elevator Shutdown.... or Preparation for Holy Week? I (Aram) was thinking how this planned elevator shutdown for maintenance (on Tuesday, April 15 from 12:30 - 3:30) falls right during Holy Week. We planned this months ago, but maybe the date chosen was providential. Perhaps those who observe the Easter Season might use it as a "preparation" for the solemn and sacred journey of the Triduum of services on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Saturday Vigil. Think of it perhaps as a 3 hour "silent retreat". I will have some handouts printed out which you can use for this, for reflection. I will put them on the little table near the large statue right outside the Chapel, on Monday April 14.

Independent Living Laundry Room Concerns: Unfortunately, issues with all the washers were full with nobody down in the laundry room doing laundry as become a concern. Unfortunately, this has been happening often. When you sign up for a laundry time, you must either remain in the laundry room, or do something to remind yourself to return when the cycle is finished. You CANNOT leave laundry in the machines. We are now telling residents who have properly reserved a spot that if a washer is full and unattended, to go ahead and pull out the laundry and leave it on top of the machine or in a basket. We will be discussing with Resident Council the possibility of locking the laundry room and checking out keys to those who have an appointment to do their laundry.

Important Sunday Brunch Clarifications: In March, we had many guests who showed up for Sunday Brunch who had not signed up. Please know that we only have limited space for guests, as we want to ensure that residents have space and are served first and foremost. Each resident may reserve up to 4 guests, until we reach 20 guests total, which is the maximum number of guests we can accommodate. The signup sheet is at the Front Desk. There are two important things to know going forward:

- 1. If guests do not have reservations, and the signup is full, they will be turned away.
- 2. Effective immediately, until further notice, guests MUST purchase a meal ticket for the buffet (and all meals at the Gardens) at the front desk using a credit card. They can no longer "charge it" to the resident's apartment/account. Thank you for your understanding.


