## **Monthly Reflection by Chaplain Aram**

Several years ago, I received a Christmas letter from Sr Nancy Surma, who, at that time, was the VP of Mission Integration at CHI Living Communities, and who supervised all the chaplains. Sr Nancy was the one who interviewed and hired me for this position (with the approval of the community). Some of you have met her, as she visited here from time to time.

In this letter, she shared a practice which she's observed for over 25 years: In the days leading up to Christmas, each year she selects one character or item in the Christmas story that she Identified with in a special way, because of where she was in her life at that point. It is an attempt to make the details surrounding the Incarnation more alive and real. Sr Nancy added that she never forces the selection: at some point as Christmas draws near, having paused for reflection, the choice is made: easily, without force, and clearly. You then sit with the message throughout the rest of the Christmas season and into the New Year, to let its message resonate. Perhaps writing out or journaling your thoughts, which can help.

Sr Nancy shared how one year, when she had resigned from a position that felt intolerable, but before she had certainly of a new position, she identified with Joseph: called to leave with Mary and the Child and flee to another land, unsure of where he would settle his family. The trust that Joseph had in God's guidance sustained her during that time. Another year, after she had lost her mother, she felt empty and alone as Christmas approached. The image that came to her in prayer was Mary, the dear mother, so that she could honor her mother's life and carry on the gifts that she had given throughout her life.

How about you? Consider these choices (and maybe you can think of others): the Angel of the Lord, the angelic hosts/choir, the shepherds in the fields at night, Mary, Joseph, the infant Jesus, the star, the animals, the manger, swaddling cloths, the fields, the magi. How might you identify with one of these characters or items? How might they reflect you? Or encourage you?

#### **Parking at GSE**

In order to insure that we have enough parking spaces for visitors and staff, we are instituting the following, effective Monday December 2:


- 1. Residents who have cars of course have a numbered parking spot assigned to them.
- 2. Staff and regular vendors have been given a parking permit (which hangs from their rear view mirror), so that they can park in any space that is NOT numbered.
- 3. For family members and other visitors who come, our sign-in sheet has been updated to have a column for those signing in who do not have a parking tag, e.g. model and color of car.
- 4. Beginning Monday, December 2, cars that are not tagged or signed in will be towed. Again, this is to ensure that residents, visitors, vendors, and staff have enough parking (at least most of the time) while we keep neighbors, North High School students, and construction workers from parking in our lot.


#### **Funnies From Betsy**
